1. Question:

What is AMSOIL Fogging Oil (FOG) used for?

Answer:

AMSOIL Fogging Oil is used to provide superior long-term protection against corrosion and dry starts for equipment operated seasonally, then stored for long periods. AMSOIL Fogging Oil keeps pistons, rings, valves and cylinder walls corrosion free.

2. Question:

What are the benefits of using AMSOIL Fogging Oil?

Answer:

- Long-term protection against corrosion and dry starts
- Extended engine life
- Reduced maintenance costs

3. Question:

How long should AMSOIL Fogging Oil be sprayed into the carburetor(s) or throttle body?

Answer:

The amount of time Fogging Oil should be sprayed differs from engine to engine. First check the operating and maintenance manual for the piece of equipment for proper storage and maintenance procedures. If not available, Fogging Oil should be sprayed into the carburetor(s) or throttle body until a change in the exhaust smoke is noticeable. Once heavy white smoke is noticed from the exhaust, turn off the engine.

4. Question:

What happens if AMSOIL Fogging Oil stalls the engine?

Answer:

While using AMSOIL Fogging Oil, it is common for the engine to stall if not under high enough RPM. If engine stalls prior to producing white exhaust smoke, restart the engine and rev it to a higher RPM just enough to keep the engine running while spraying Fogging Oil.
